



Sepsis moves fast. Recognition should move faster.

World Aid Through Connected Health is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit equipping frontline maternal, newborn, and pediatric care teams in under-resourced settings with connected-health tools, training, and implementation support to recognize signs of clinical deterioration earlier — while there is still time to act.

A concerning change noticed earlier can change the course of care.

THE CHALLENGE

15%

of all newborn deaths are caused by sepsis — a leading cause, with about 3 million newborn cases a year.

2.9M

children under five die of sepsis each year, most in low-resource settings. (WHO)

Most

child sepsis deaths could be prevented through early diagnosis and timely care. (WHO)

1 in 5

deaths worldwide is linked to sepsis — ~11 million a year, ~85% of it in low-resource settings.

In under-resourced clinics, mothers, newborns, and children are often checked by hand, intermittently, and on paper — **if at all**. By the time deterioration is obvious, the window to intervene may already be closing.

OUR MODEL

A complete, field-ready program — not a device drop.

- 01 Local partnership**
Built with committed local clinics and champions, never imposed from outside.
- 02 Connected equipment**
Low-cost wearables, phones, and connectivity — including satellite where needed.
- 03 Training & workflows**
Hands-on education in monitoring, recognition, and clear escalation.
- 04 Implementation support**
Coordinators and educators who make the tools fit a busy ward.
- 05 Signal summaries**
OpenDx partner technology organizes available health signals into clear summaries that support clinician review.
- 06 Evidence & learning**
We measure what works and share a practical model others can replicate.

A 12-month pilot across two to three care settings — the people, devices, connectivity, training, and evaluation that make connected health genuinely useful and safe.
